**Mt. Vernon UU Fellowship services are held each Sunday at 10:00 a.m.**

**October 4<sup>th</sup>: *Open Reading Service.*** This service will be an open reading service with no designated leader. Please bring short readings, thoughts, music, artwork, or other appropriate material to share with the congregation.

**October 11<sup>th</sup>: *Topic to be announced.*** Shannon Green will lead this service with a topic to be announced. After the service, the fellowship will host its regular social hour, but will follow that with the first official meeting of the newly formed taskforce for Social Justice and Action. This is an informal task force and everyone is invited to participate and learn about and discuss current social justice issues happening locally and beyond.

**October 18<sup>th</sup>: *Open Reading Service followed by Membership Meeting.*** Adam E. Stone will coordinate this Open Readings Service. Please bring short readings, thoughts, music, artwork, or other appropriate material to share with the congregation. Following the service there will be a membership meeting in the sanctuary, featuring discussion of becoming a Welcoming Congregation and of how members and regular attendees can become more involved with the various committees that enable the fellowship to function.

**October 25<sup>th</sup>: *We are still in need of a volunteer to lead this service.*** Please sign up to lead the service by placing your name on the sign up sheet at the sanctuary entrance near the offering bowls.

All Sunday services are followed by a social hour with coffee and other refreshments in the fellowship basement immediately after the service.

**November 1<sup>st</sup> Service: *Special Guests The Image Spinners ~ Our Open Lives: Experience, Change, Growth and Becoming.*** The *Image Spinners* is “an eclectic circle of women writers” exploring and celebrating the richness of their life experiences in diverse ways, while utilizing a variety of genres such as poetry, fiction, and memoir to shape the experiences into meaningful patterns and tapestries. Themes and concerns reflected in their writing naturally cover many of the Unitarian Universalist principles, although this is not their main purpose in creating and expressing.

During the service, several *Image Spinners* will read from their work, thus sharing with the community their interpretation and depiction of the threads of life that connect us all.
