If you are leading a service, or planning a fellowship event, please email your information to Beth at: bethvito@mvn.net by (at the very latest) 8 a.m., on the prior Wednesday. It need not be complicated--a few sentences would be fine. (Also, please let Beth know if you do not wish for your name to be included in the press release.) Many new attendees have told us that they found MVUUF through these articles in the newspaper, so this is an important way to let people know what is happening.

Newsletter Submission Guidelines

All submissions for *UU Matters* should be emailed to Luke at LukeSanfordCrawford@yahoo.com. Submissions for the December edition must be emailed no later than **Monday, November 22**.

If you are leading a service or speaking in a service, you need to submit the title, date, and synopsis of your service/sermon.

If you are coordinating a special meeting or event that is open to the public, you need to submit the date and description of the event.

UU Matters is an opportunity for you to share your personal work relating to Unitarian Universalism, to the MVUUF congregation, or to liberal religious thought in general. Please consider sharing your photography, poems, short stories, "deep thoughts," etc.
